### Certification at the BASIC/AICC LEVEL:

- Complete a 40-hour POST Basic/AICC Instructor Certification Course
- Validation of competencies in the classroom



- Complete the 40-hour Intermediate Course; or
- Complete the 24-hour Intermediate Instructional Skills
- Complete the 8-hour Presentation Skills Course
- Complete the 8-hour Critical Thinking Skills Course; and
- Complete the 16-hour Instructional Technology Course



### Certification at the ADVANCED LEVEL:

- Complete the 40-hour Advanced Instructor Development Core Course with a 16-hour Teach Back session (56-hrs total)
- Complete the 24-hour Leadership, Mentoring and Coaching Course



#### Certification at the MASTER LEVEL:

- Complete the Master Instructor Certification Course (MICC); designing, developing and delivering a minimum of a 24-hour course that meets a demonstrated and POST approved training need
- The candidate's Total Training Package (TTP) will be formally evaluated by a panel prior to course delivery




#### **Re-Certification**

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

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
# IDI LEVEL 2: INTERMEDIATE


